- Check Flexible Fuel
- > Check Oil Level
- Change Oil (5w-30 synthetic) Every 200 hours or annually
- > Inspect Enclosure Louvers
- Vibration, noise, leakage, freeze protection
- > Remove corrosion, ensure dryness
- > Clean and tighten battery terminals
- > Check charge state
- > Complete Battery test
- Apply conditioner and wax
- > Inspect/Replace air cleaner
- > Inspect/Replace Spark plug(s)
- Apply corrosion inhibiting spray to engine parts
- > Tighten terminals
- > Check for proper operation
- Check control wiring connections
- > Check No load output voltage
 - o Line to line 240 volts
 - Line to neutral 120 volts
 - o Line to ground 120 volts
- > Inspect Grounding conductor
- > Check Earth ground
- Check DC control fuse
- > Check Battery charger fuse
- > Test Auto/off/manual switch
- > Inspect Levelness of generator
- > Complete Load test & Transfer test
